Important Reminders

PE lessons continue to be taught on Wednesday afternoons (inside) and Friday mornings (outside).

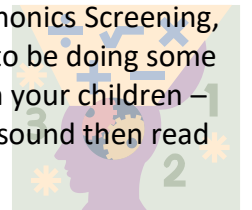
Homework
