Time

Important Reminders:

READING

Children should be changing their reading books independently when they need to. Children need to keep a record of their independent reading in the reading diary in Showbie.

They should be aiming to read at least three times per week in order to keep making good progress with their reading.

We cannot stress enough the importance of regular opportunities for your child to read. This can be any type of text, not always their reading book!

iPads

Please remind children to bring in their iPads **fully charged** every day.

Drop off and pick up

Children will enter the school grounds at 8:45 via the front main gate. At the end of the day, they will leave at 3:15 via their classroom entrance.

Other notices:
